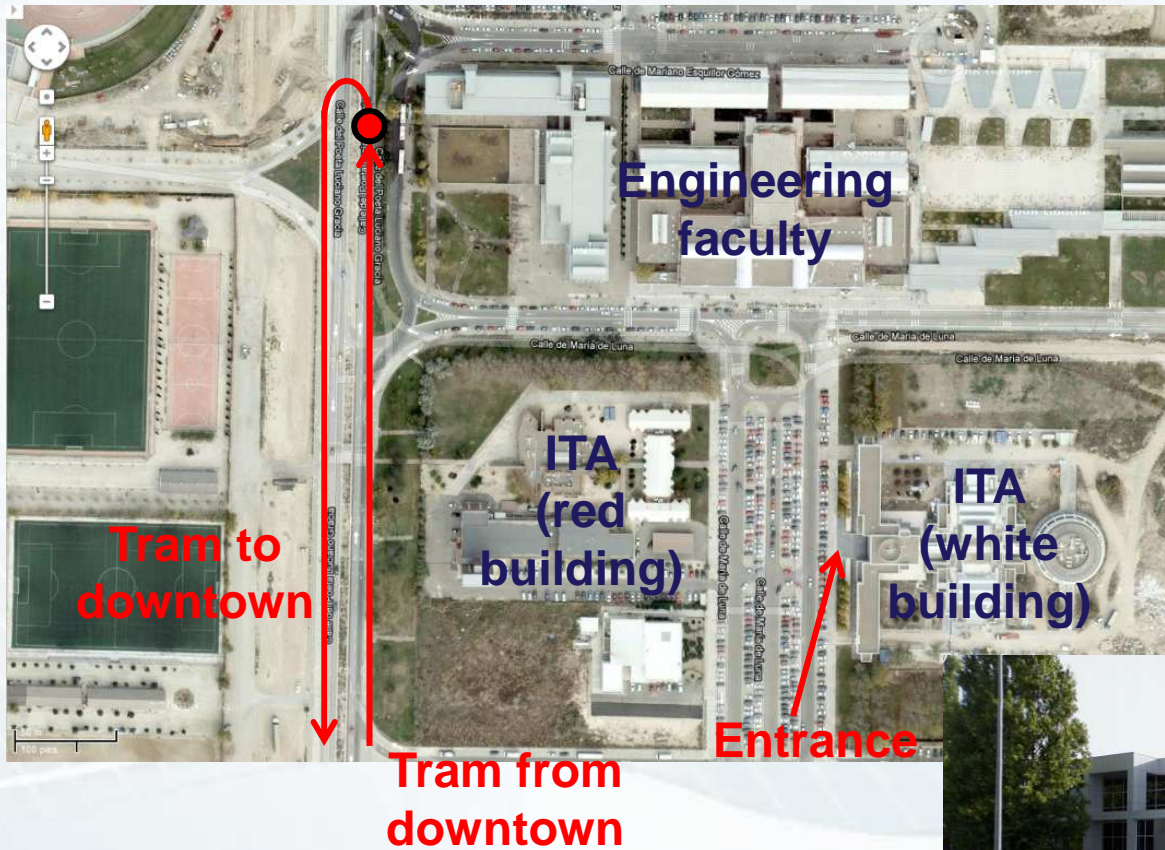

If you fly to Madrid...

Going to Zaragoza by car:

315 km, around 3.5 h on the highway

Going to Zaragoza by train:

From the airport (Barajas) to Madrid rail station (Atocha) there are three options:

- Bus shuttle (Airport Express) connects the terminal 4 of the airport with the train station every 15 min (30 min trip, fare 2 €)

- Underground (it takes around 45 min, 2.5 €)

- Taxi (20 to 40 min trip, around 25 €)

Afterwards at the Madrid train station (Atocha) take a high speed train (AVE) to Zaragoza-Delicias. One train every hour (approx.), from 6h til 21h. Trip takes around 90 min approx.

If you fly to Barcelona...

Going to Zaragoza by car:

300 km, around 3 h on the highway

Going to Zaragoza by train:

From the airport (El Prat) to Barcelona rail station (Sants) there are two options:

- Train (Rodalies line R2) connects the terminal 2 of the airport with the train station (Sants) every 30 min (19 min trip, fare 3.60 €)

- Taxi (20 to 30 min trip, around 25 €)

Afterwards at the Barcelona train station (Sants) take a high speed train (AVE) to Zaragoza-Delicias. One train every hour (approx.), from 6h til 21h. Trip takes around 90 min approx.

If you fly straight to Zaragoza...

From Zaragoza airport to ITA there are two options:

- Bus shuttle airport-downtown every 30 min. (45 min. trip, fare 1.60 €). Stop at María Agustín, then take the tram in Plaza Aragón (15 min. trip, 1,35 €), stops at Escuela de Ingenieros.
- Taxi (20 min. trip, 20-25 €)
